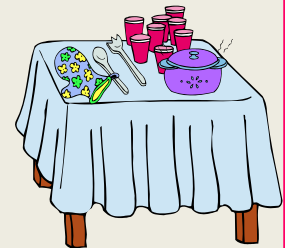

### Years 1 & 2 Multi-Skills Festival

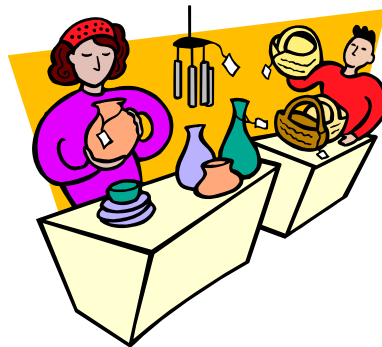
