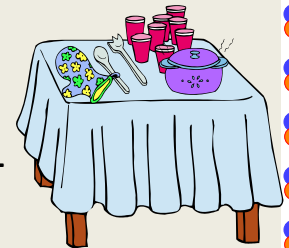
End of Term

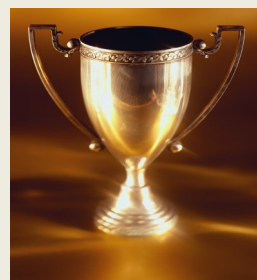
