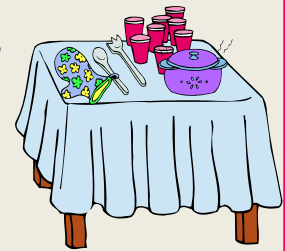
### School Photographer

### Zumba

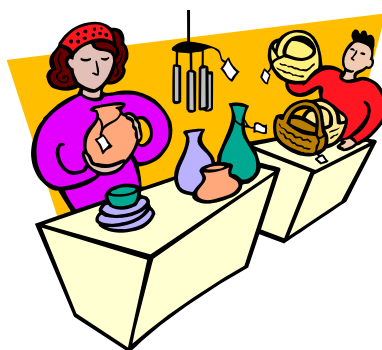
Just to remind you that Zumba Club starts this Monday at 3.15 p.m. We will still hold Gardening Club and Football Club on Mondays too.
