Self Isolation

If your family has the need to self isolate next term please let school know as soon as possible and work will be set by the Class Teacher Dojo (as per the Government requirement), on Class Dojo for your child/ren to complete each day. Work can then be sent back to school via Class Dojo to be marked. If a child has symptoms they need to self isolate and take a test as soon as possible. If the test brings a negative result the child can return to school, if the result is positive school must be notified and your child must stay off school for 10 days. Please keep school informed each day of how your child is. Thank you.
