Intent

The intention of the Geography Curriculum in our school is to inspire pupil curiosity about their world and to engage them in outdoor learning and geographical enquiry.

Implementation

The implementation of the curriculum has been sequenced to enable pupils to gradually widen their sense of scale from their immediate geography to the global. Case studies in KS1 reflect a regional area of the North East to then contrast with a country in Africa; Kenya. In KS2, the regional case study of the North East is deepened and used as the basis for comparison to our chosen region of Europe, the Bay of Naples and then the area around San Paulo in Brazil. Throughout KS1 and KS2 map and fieldwork knowledge is developed through a series of field based enquiries.

Impact

The impact of this, when it has been fully rolled out and experienced in its entirety, will be that, by the end of Y6, our pupils will be equipped with the necessary geographical skills and knowledge to be secondary ready and continue to be curious about their world.
