Class 1

English

Over the Summer Term in English Year 1 and 2 children will continue to complete work on their book 'Man on the Moon' (A day in the life of Bob) by Simon Bartram. In addition to this, we are going to look at some slightly older language and literacy, as we will study William Shakespeare his life and work. The children will also carry out some Poetry work. In Year 1 and 2 the children are learning how to write for different purposes and audiences and we are continuing to work on our word classes and use of punctuation.
