## **French Long-Term Plan**

**LKS2** - **Pupils** in year 3 are new to French and those in year 4 have had a year of fortnightly lessons in French.

- Phonics will be embedded throughout the topic areas to develop accurate pronunciation and intonation, and link spelling, sound and meaning of words.
- Pupils will be able to produce simple sentences, answer familiar questions and explore simple grammatical concepts.
- They will learn to appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in the language and develop **intercultural understanding** and foster positive attitudes by learning about key festivals in French speaking countries.
